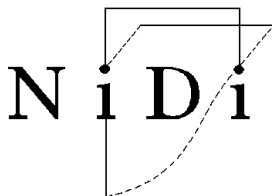

Overview¹

Mission

NIDI's mission is to study population issues in their social context. It seeks to do so by conducting top-quality scientific research into population issues (its core activity) and disseminating demographic knowledge and information to stakeholders in academia, policy and society at large. NIDI was affiliated to the KNAW in 2003 and is the only social science institute among the current 17 research institutes of the Academy.

Scope

NIDI seeks to further strengthen its position as a unique national and leading international institute for population studies. This requires that it is firmly embedded in national and international networks. In the Netherlands it does so through focused collaboration with universities and policy makers, such as government ministries and policy analysis agencies. While continuing to have a solid grounding in the Netherlands, NIDI aspires to secure a position as a European centre of excellence in the face of a changing academic research environment in Europe: a shared and highly competitive European Research Area. NIDI participates actively in EU Framework Programmes, initiatives of the European Research Council and the European Science Foundation and in policy research commissioned by the European Commission and the United Nations. The Institute also contributes actively to education and training as part of national and international programmes.

Strategy and evaluation

Based on its strategic objectives, NIDI research focuses on a limited number of research priorities using integrated theoretical, analytical and empirical frameworks based on the core concepts of life course, generation and social interdependence. This common integrated framework is shared by the research strands and projects in its work programme. The key elements are an interdisciplinary perspective, an international orientation and a good balance between basic and applied research.

The overriding theme of NIDI research is "Lives in Contexts". Studying lives and life courses in context shows that demographic trends at macro level can

only be fully grasped if one has an understanding of demographic behaviour at micro level. This central theme is further fleshed out in the research strands Early and Late Stages in the Life course, Intergenerational Relations, Population Trends and Policy, Projections and Models, Migration and Integration, and Health.

In the framework of its external review, NIDI conducted a self assessment entitled 'New Balance. Self Assessment NIDI 2007'. An important focus of NIDI is to achieve a new balance in the face of a changing environment and the different types of research carried out by NIDI. The External Review Panel visited NIDI at the beginning of 2008 and its Evaluation Report is set to be published during the course of 2008.

Performance

NIDI depends largely (60%) on external funding. The Institute has shown to be increasingly effective in acquiring projects that are in keeping with NIDI's mission. In 2007, for example, NIDI was highly successful in the Seventh EU Framework Programme, for which all four applications in which NIDI was involved were granted. The projects concerned were 'Multilinks', a study into intergenerational relations headed by NIDI, the project 'Reproductive Decision-making in a Macro-Micro perspective' (REPRO), a study into family formation decisions, 'Gender 2007', a study into the causes and consequences of demographic trends, and 'Activating Senior Potential in Aging Europe' (ASPA), a project about the labour force participation of older adults. In the European Science Foundation, NIDI successfully acquired the EUROSCORES programme HumVIB, which focuses on family formation. Other funding was secured from the United Nations (UNFPA), EU directorates and various Dutch government ministries.

NIDI raises its profile through a comprehensive publication programme targeted at the academic community (scientific journals and books), at policy makers (policy papers, reports for donors/sponsors) and at society at large (reports for the general public, the media). NIDI has succeeded in achieving an ever higher output in recent years, with a particularly strong increase in the number of publications in major journals included in the (Social) Science Citation Index. At the same time it saw an increase in the number of articles in the media and in more accessible, widely distributed publications with a broader audience.

From the beginning of 2008, the series of NIDI reports, which have so far been published in-house, will be published by Aksant Publishers, under the imprint of KNAW Press. The popular bulletin DEMOS, which targets a broad audience, will remain one of NIDI's most important publications.

Organisation

NIDI was reorganised in 2007 with a view to providing greater scope for scientific innovation and reducing the Institute's financial vulnerability. The number of research departments was cut back from three to two, and the Population and Development department was closed down. All employees who had to leave NIDI as a result of the reorganisation immediately found a new job. The innovation in its scientific programme came mainly from an impulse given to health economic research, which is set to take further shape in the new Projections, Migration & Health (PMH) department.

NIDI Scientific Output in 2007

This chapter summarizes the scientific output of NIDI in the year 2007. The output is classified in two ways. In the first section the output is presented according to the criteria agreed upon in the Standard Evaluation Protocol 2003-2009 for public research organizations in the Netherlands (SEP). This section comprises the following categories of output:

1. Academic Publications, including articles in refereed (top) Journals (1.1), articles in other refereed Journals (1.2), articles in other Journals (1.3), and book chapters (1.4).
2. Monographs and books.
3. PhD theses.
4. Professional publications and products, including scientific dissemination articles in Demos (4.1), other reports (4.2), software, databases, CD's, questionnaires (4.3), book reviews (4.4) and articles in other media (4.5).

In the second section, other professional output of NIDI is presented to complement the picture presented in the SEP classification. To reflect NIDI's broad mission, this professional output is subdivided into "science" oriented and "society/policy" oriented, as follows:

5. Other professional SCIENCE oriented output, including academic chairs (5.1), editorships of journals (5.2), editorships of books (5.3), referees/discussants (5.4), courses/classes taught (5.5), PhDs supervised (5.6), research trainees supervised (5.7), workshops/seminars organized (5.8) and working papers/conference papers (5.9).
6. Other professional SOCIETY/POLICY oriented, output, including committees and boards (6.1), advising and consultancies (6.2), lectures and presentations (6.3), press releases /newsletters (6.4) and media coverage (6.5).

A summary overview of the scientific output of NIDI is presented in Table 1, where the 2007 data are presented in the perspective of the trends since the year 2000. The data show an overall increase of productivity over the period under review (see also New Balance, Self Assessment NIDI 2007).
